The One Hundred Club was formed in 2007 along the lines of existing clubs run by both Hereford and Worcester Choral Societies. The aim of the club is to provide funds for the Choral Society whilst at the same time giving members a chance to win cash prizes at draws, usually made three or four times per year. At present the prizes are £50, £25 and £15, although these amounts may be up for review in the coming months.

The funding of the Club is by way of the sale of shares which are priced at £1 per share per month or £12 per share per annum, payable three months at a time or £3 or multiples thereof quarterly. There is no limit on the number of shares that a member can hold. Unfortunately, the take-up by members has not been particularly good as only 40 members, two of which are no longer singing, have subscribed - out of a society membership of 150. Those who have subscribed have done so very enthusiastically, holding 86 shares between them.

Since its inception in 2007 the club has paid out £730 in prizes and given £1000 to the society's general account and this is whilst the initial target of 100 shares has never been reached.

This is an appeal to any member who has not taken shares to consider joining. With a minimum of £1 per month there is a chance of winning £50 and at the same time contributing towards the society's funds. An application form is in the Members Only area of the GCS website too, which when completed should be handed to Norman Elliott (2nd Bass), any member of the committee or your section representative. Any shares allotted will be included in the next draw which at the time of writing will be on 20th March 2010.
